 - "Schedule A Services" indicates that services identified as F3 will be payable on the basis of time-based rates
 - "Schedule D Pricing" asks for an estimated fee for F3 services to possibly be used as a Cash Allowance
- A1. The City requires detailed Proposals covering all specified services to enable accurate budgeting. Additionally, we require the flexibility to opt for a cash allocation if needed, allowing for alternative service arrangements.
