The applicant is proposing a text amendment to the Southwest Coquitlam Area Plan and Maillardville Neighbourhood Plan (part of the OCP) to permit Places of Worship use at the subject sites, designated as Business Enterprise, as indicated on the attached map marked "Subject Properties 1963 Lougheed Highway and 1880 Coleman Avenue."
