## **Notice of Public Consultation – Temporary Use Permit**

The applicant is requesting a TUP to permit overnight winter shelter use (as part of the Tri-Cities Winter Shelter Program) in the P-2 Special Institutional zone. The Shelter, which would accommodate between 20 to 25 people, would operate overnight between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. and be accessed through van transportation to and from the Shelter from drop off and pick up locations throughout the Tri-Cities. 
