QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS

- Q1. We would like to request a 2-week extension for this project, as many of our vendors are at a limited capacity due to the holidays and can not get pricing in time for the current closing date.
- A1. At this time the City will not be extending the deadline.
- Q2. The RFP document states that an Asbestos Abatement License is a mandatory requirement. Demolition contractors don't typically carry this designation or perform hazardous materials abatement. Please advise if using a licensed hazardous materials abatement subcontractor is acceptable.
- A2. The City's preference is for the demolition Contractor to carry the abatement license.
- Q3. Several of our hazardous materials abatement subcontractors are requesting a second site visit. Please advise if a second site visit can be scheduled.
- A3. At this time the City will not be offering a second site visit.
