Proponents shall note the following amendments to the RFP documents:

QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS

Q1. How many applications and management tools does QNet operate?

A1. QNet operates 1, Enghouse Netdesigner a fibre network GIS.

Q2. How large is the QNet data centre?

A2. The data centre for QNet is spread over 2 location. One location hold 22 racks plus an optical distribution frame the second location holds 4 racks plus an optical distribution frame.

Q3. How many racks does the QNet data centre occupy?

A3. Location one has 22 total racks with 14 available for lease. Location two has 4 racks with no availability for lease.

Q4. How many network testing equipment and tools does QNet own?

A4. QNet owns 5 network testing equipment and tools, this includes an optical time domain reflectometer, live fibre detector, power meter and 2 visible light source

Q5. For the supplementary scope of work, under security vulnerabilities, are we expected to complete a physical assessment and a cyber-security assessment?

A5. No a physical assessment and cyber security assessment is not required. An assessment of the information obtained through documentation, interview and any virtual scans would be sufficient to fulfill this requirement.

Q6. The level of effort required for the Supplementary Scope of Work (Item 3.4) is unclear without knowing the number of applications, size of the data centre, security assessment requirements, and amount of fibre test equipment. Can we price this item after award or based on time and material?

A6. Proponents are expected to provide a comprehensive cost impact, including total cost, for the engagement based on the information in the RFP documents including any addenda. Information on number of applications, size of the data centre, security assessment requirements, and amount of fibre test equipment is included in Addendum No. 1 (see above).
