Notice is hereby given that the City of Coquitlam will be holding a Public Hearing on **Monday**, **July 28**, **2025**, at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall Council Chambers, 3000 Guildford Way, Coquitlam, BC V3B 7N2 to receive representations from all persons who deem it in their interest to address Council regarding the following proposed bylaws.

The intent of **Bylaw No. 5466, 2025** is to amend *Citywide Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 3479, 2001* to amend the land use designation of a portion of the subject property as outlined in black on the map marked "Schedule 'A' to Bylaw No. 5466, 2025" from Medium Density Apartment Residential to High Density Apartment Residential and permit the construction of a 29-storey market strata tower on the western portion of the site.

The intent of **Bylaw No. 5456, 2025** is to amend *City of Coquitlam Zoning Bylaw No. 3000, 1996* to rezone the subject property as outlined in black on the map marked "Schedule 'B' to Bylaw 5456, 2025" from RM-1 Two-Storey Low Density Apartment Residential and RT-2 Townhouse Residential Zones to CD-43 Comprehensive Development Zone – 43 and remove the maximum 6-storey height restriction applicable to the property.

If approved, this multi-phased application would facilitate the construction of a 29-storey market strata tower on the western portion of the site west of Kensal Place extension, a 6-storey purpose-build rental building, seven 6- to 7-storey market strata buildings, and a childcare facility on the eastern portion of the site east of Kensal Place extension.


