- Q1. Can an extension be provided for the bid closing date?
- A1. The bid closing date was already extended to Oct 24 (see Addendum #1). Please monitor the City's website for further addenda.
- Q2. Do you have a defined budget for this project?
- A2. See Addendum No 2.
- Q3. Regarding the Scope of Work item "c", specifically the line "Confirm realistic emergency scenarios…". Does the City anticipate this scope to include developing and implementing new technical analyses/studies to determine the characteristics of a failure (i.e., anticipated infrastructure that will be impacted, and to what extent) which may lead to an emergency scenario, or is the analysis intended to review the impact of a pre-established set of characteristics of infrastructure failure?
- A3. Scope of Work Item 'c' confirm realistic emergency scenarios is intended only for a high-level conceptual review. New technical analyses/studies are not intended to be completed as a part of this assignment. The focus of this assignment is on Items d-g, where the resulting materials will be adaptable and scalable to a wide range of potential emergency supply scenarios.
- Q4. The Final Completion Date for this work is listed as April 22, 2026. Is the City open to extending the timeline for completion if it were considered to be beneficial for project outcomes?
- A4. Yes, the City will consider adjustments to the timeline if they are demonstrated to be beneficial to the overall project outcomes
