## **QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS**

- Q1. Could the City please share the last 3 years of EFAP utilization data, including:
  - a. # of cases opened per year
  - b. Average sessions per case
  - c. Presenting issues or themes
- A1. While budgeted utilization is 17%, the actual annual utilization in 2024/2025 is approximately 11%, which is consistent with past years. The City's top 5 services include: Counselling, Nutrition, Career, Financial and Legal and our top 5 issues are Stress, Workplace Stress, Anxiety, Relationship and Communication/Conflict Resolution. We do not currently have data on average sessions per case.
- Q2. Are there any specific focus areas (e.g., First Responders, Indigenous engagement, or diversity & inclusion) that should be emphasized?
- A2. Currently the City's focus is on better mental health support across all employee groups, customized to the employee based on culture, demographics and where they are on the mental health continuum. Please note that first responders are not included in this RFIQ.
- Q3. How do you measure mental health beyond usage?
- A3. The City does not currently measure mental health beyond usage however, going forward, the City wants to track related mental illness disability absences frequency and durations.
- Q4. Would the City prefer a per employee per month rate or an hour rate provided?
- A4. The City would like to see both a per employee per month rate and an hour rate provided.
- Q5. Please explain what is meant by "standalone fees for specific services should the City contract with separate vendors."?
- A5. Submissions should include Standalone fees for specific services should the City contract with separate vendors for services such as Critical Incident Stress

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Management (CISM) and Trauma Response or Group Workshops or Webinars on specialized topics.
