Proponents shall note the following amendments to the RFP documents:

QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS

Q1. Could you please extend to March 17?

A1. There will be not be an extension granted at this time.

Q2. Could you please confirm why FIFA certification is required for a baseball field application? As FIFA standards are typically associated with soccer fields, we would like to better understand the intent behind this specification and whether an equivalent baseball-specific performance standard would be acceptable.

A2. The wear simulator testing to FIFA standards remains a requirement of this RFP and is included as a recognized performance benchmark for durability and surface performance.

Q3. Are you open to other colour variations or patterns for the turf infield other than solid green?

A3. The City is open to considering alternative colour variations or patterns for the turf infield:

- **Where a proposed colour variation has no impact on the Proposal, final confirmation will occur during the shop drawing review process prior to product confirmation**

- **Where proposed colour variation results in a change to the proposed Price, the cost implication must be clearly identified in the Proponent's Proposal**

Q4. Can a turf be submitted that meets all FIFA performance standards and tests, and all the specifications of the RFP, but the turf's manufacturer is not a FIFA-certified manufacturer?"

A4. Yes, a turf system may be submitted provided it meets all specified FIFA performance standards and testing requirements outlined in the RFP, regardless of whether the manufacturer is a FIFA-certified manufacturer. Proponents must clearly demonstrate compliance with all required performance standards and provide supporting documentation with their Proposal.
