Questions & Clarifications

Q1) Can the pavement markings be also completed on Saturdays between 9am and 9pm like the paving work?

A1) Pavement marking work can be completed on Saturdays.

Q2) Will the Contractor have unrestricted access to the parking lot during grading and paving?

A2) A detailed schedule will need to be provided by the Contractor as per the Supplementary Specifications - Contract Specific Notations, Clause 00 72 43S. Full un-restricted access to the parking lot will be provided for grading and excavation works during the weekday between 7:00am and 7:00pm. Refer to Appendix A – Traffic Management Detail Specifications, Clause 5.2 – Site Specific Considerations for additional details.

Through access for ingress and egress movements to and from the Works Yard Buildings must be maintained.

Q3) Can the City confirm with a TMP will be required? Does the City have any specific requirements or preferences regarding the number of Traffic Control Persons (TCP's) to be present on site during construction?

A3) At this time the City does not anticipate a TMP will be required. The Contractor should assume at least 1 TCP should be present at all times to help with City vehicle ingress and egress as required.
