Notice of New Liquor Licence – Scratch Indoor Golf and Academy – 641 Lougheed Highway

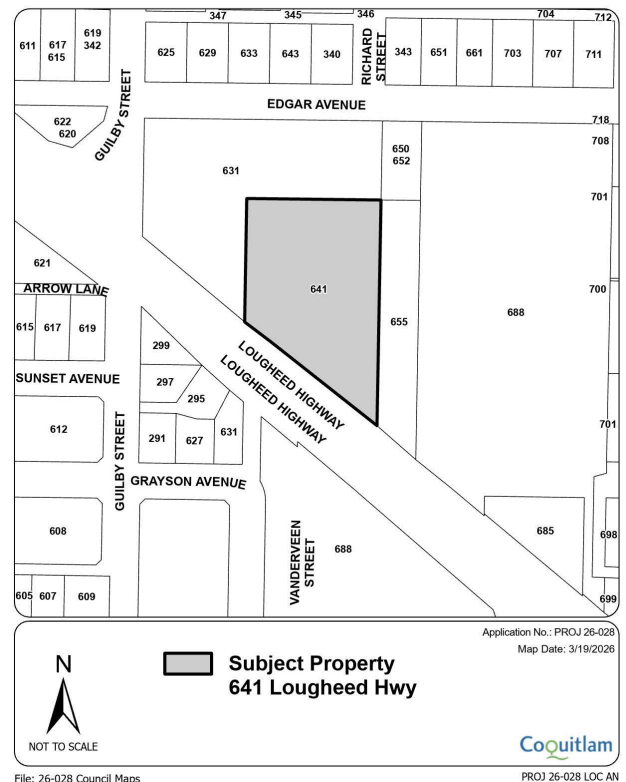
The Scratch Indoor Golf and Academy, located at 641 Lougheed Highway, Coquitlam has applied to the Liquor and Cannabis Regulation Branch (LCRB) for a new primary Liquor Licence. If approved, the licence would:

1. Provide liquor service at the following proposed hours: **from 10:00 a.m. – 1:00 a.m. Sunday – Thursday** and **10:00 a.m. – 2:00 a.m. Friday – Saturday**. The current hours of business are from **10:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. Sunday – Thursday** and **10:00 a.m. – 11:00 p.m. Friday – Saturday**; and
2. Permit patrons to have alcohol in the following areas: sales floor, lesson rooms, putting area, and simulator rooms.

In accordance with the *Liquor Control and Licensing Act and Regulations*, the City of Coquitlam has been asked to provide comments and a recommendation on the application to the LCRB.

The City invites the public to provide input to Council with respect to how the change to this licence, if approved, may affect them and their property. The City of Coquitlam will be receiving input on this application until **5 p.m. April 20, 2026**. Written correspondence can be provided in one of the following ways:

Input received will be provided to Council in the form of a report at a Regular Council Meeting. Council will consider the input provided and submit a formal recommendation on the application to the LCRB.
