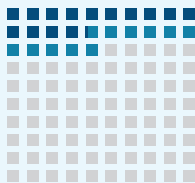

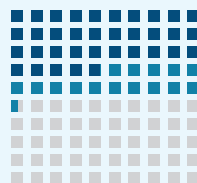

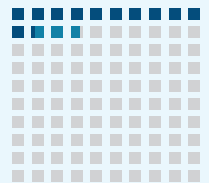
Preschool Age
