Q1. Section 32 52 00 – Synthetic turf, item 1.1.E and item 2.11.H, the spec calls for a 100% monofilament using a 23mm thick shock pad and meeting WR and FIFA testing requirements. Are we allowed to provide with our bid submittal, a WR and FIFA test report using a 20mm to confirm adherence to the requirements? We would still bid with a 23mm pad, it's just that we don't have this combination (100% mono + 23mm pad) tested.

A1. Proponents may submit a FIFA testing report for a product that is very similar to the product being proposed, such as a difference in fibre height (ie. same turf system but different fibre height) or a turf product on a slightly different shock pad. Under this scenario, the Proponent is to provide assurance that the system difference(s) will not negatively impact compliance with the submitted testing reports.

Q2. Section 32 18 23.39 – Synthetic track, item 3.4.4.1 – the spec asks to retain a legal surveyor licensed in the province of British Columbia, can we hire a World Athletics approved surveyor with experience to the layout of the track and measurement report?

A2. A World Athletics approved surveyor would also be acceptable for layout and Measurement Report purposes.
